# 1. Unit description



- 1 U-Cap unit
- 2 Unit Case
- 3 Flash drives
- 4 Micro USB port
- 5 USB port
- 6 semicircular indentation

### 2. Before you start

#### 2.1. General

U-Cap has been designed to operate automatically, with as little user involvement as possible.

#### 2.2. Prerequisites

Before using U-Cap, you must have the following:

- 2.2.1. A working Unlocker unit with software version 1.3 and above installed.
  - 2.2.1.1. For instructions on how to check your Unlocker version, please refer to the Unlocker manual.
  - 2.2.1.2. If you do not have the 1.3 version or above, please download and install latest version from the support site. For instructions on how to download and install the latest version, please refer to the Unlocker manual.
- 2.2.2. A U-Cap specific pre-formatted USB flash drive loaded with payload.
  - 2.2.2.1. Download the U-Cap manager from support site and format flash drives according to instructions in appendix A
  - 2.2.2.2. Use the manager to load your payload onto flash drive see appendix A
  - 2.2.2.3. Should you wish to prepare and format your own Flash drive and load your payload by yourself, please refer to Appendix B of this manual. We strongly suggest that you use the manager supplied as it will ensure the drive is configured correctly. If you choose not to use the manager, we cannot and will not take any responsibility for the correct operation on the unit.

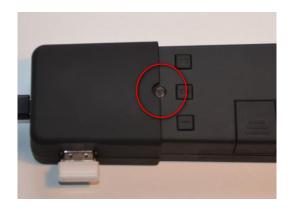
### 3. Running the unit

**Step A -** Check the state of the target PC:

- If the PC is powered off start the PC (power on), and wait for the logon screen to appear. Once the logon screen appears, wait an additional two minutes for background services to complete loading, then continue to Step B.
- If the PC is powered on but not locked, you can use the U-Cap to execute your payload with SYSTEM privileges. To do so, start by locking the PC (via the windows menu or by hitting windows key + L) and then continue to Step B. Note however that after a successful execution the PC will remain locked.
- If the PC is locked continue to step B.

#### Step B

Connect the U-Cap unit to the Unlocker unit until semicircular indentation on U-Cap engulfs the LED indicator on the Unlocker unit.



Step C

Plug in the pre-formatted and payload loaded Flash drive into unit USB plug

**Step D**Plug in the Micro USB connector of the Unlocker USB cable to U-Cap's Micro USB socket



Step E

Plug in the other side of the USB cable into any free USB port on the target PC. If possible, use a USB2 port and not USB3 (blue) port.

#### Step F

Follow the steps as detailed in the table below - these are the same steps as running Unlocker, except for the last stage.

	Red light flashing 2 seconds on, followed by 2 seconds off	Power-on fail	Disconnect and reconnect unit

	Constant red light	Power-on fail	Disconnect and reconnect unit
After up to 30 sec	Green light flashing = 0.5 seconds on followed by 0.5 seconds off	Unit is ready	Please enter 4 digit PIN code
	Red light on	Unit locked - too many wrong PIN codes entered	Contact Technical Support
	Red light flashing 0.5 seconds on followed by 0.5 seconds off	Unit has been tampered with	Contact Technical Support
Use the buttons on the unit to enter the 4-digit PIN code	Green light flashing 2 seconds on followed by 2 seconds off	Code correct, unlocking in progress	Wait for success (see below)
	Yellow light flashing twice = 0.5 seconds on followed by 0.5 seconds off, then light is back to constant green	Wrong PIN code entered	Try again with correct PIN code. you have 7 tries
	Red light on	Unit is locked after 7 wrong tries	Contact Technical Support
	Green light on	Payload installed successfully	Wait 10 sec and disconnect
	After 4 min - Red light flashing 2 seconds on followed by 2 seconds off	Unlocking failed	Disconnect and reconnect unit, and try again. If possible, use another free USB port. Possible problem with payload file.
Very rare occasion	Red light flashing 0.5 seconds on followed by 0.5 seconds off	Unit has been tampered with	Contact Technical Support

#### Step G

Once the process is completed successfully, the only feedback you will receive is a constant green LED on the unlocker unit. We recommend that once you see the constant green light, wait another 10 seconds before disconnecting the USB cable from PC.

## 4. Disconnecting Unlocker

When you disconnect the unit, do your best to put the PC back in the state it was before connecting the unit, locking, logging the user off, or powering the PC off if necessary.

# 5. Troubleshooting

#	Situation	Action	Remark
1	USB plugged-in but no white light shows	Unplug and try again. If still no light, try on a different USB port. If still no light, try on another PC	
		If light OK on other USB port.	The target PC USB port is not working properly.
		Still no light on another PC	The unit may be damaged, please contact Technical Support
2	After plugging the device to the target PC's USB port, the white light comes on but doesn't change to flashing green after 60 seconds	Unplug and try again If still no light, try on another PC	
		If light OK on other USB port	The target PC USB port is not working properly.
		If light still doesn't change to flashing green on another PC	The unit may be damaged, please contact Technical Support
3	The process fails (light changes from flashing green to flashing red after 4 minutes)	Unplug and try again. Make sure Flash drive is plugged in properly If still doesn't work, try a different USB port. Try again for 3 times.	If still no success - the PC is unlockable

### 6. Remarks

- 6.1. If you connect the U-Cap combined with Unlocker to a PC without the USB Flash drive connected, the attack will fail and you will get the red LED light after the 4-minute timeout.
- 6.2. Any U-Cap unit will work with any Unlocker unit as long as the Unlocker unit has firmware version 1.3 or above installed.

# 7. Compliance testing and anti-tampering

Do not attempt to use any tools to test the unit, as this will likely make the unit self-destruct.

Only use on computers running windows OS for PC from Windows Vista and above for Windows Server from 2008 and above. Using on computers running other OS may cause unit to self-destruct.

The way the Unlocker works is protected intellectual property (IP), and to keep that IP safe the unit implements advanced anti-tampering methods. Any tampering attempt will cause the unit to self-destruct, and any damage caused will not be covered by the warranty.

If you wish to test the unit for compliance or other reasons, please contact our local distributor/representative with your test plan, and we will check which tests can be run safely, and offer alternatives to tests that cannot.
